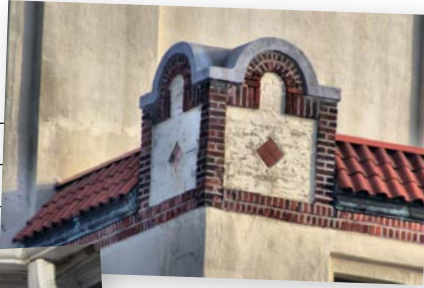

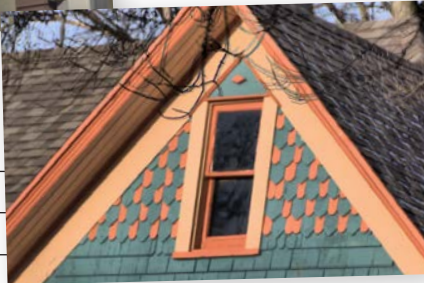


I was built in 1883 of course.

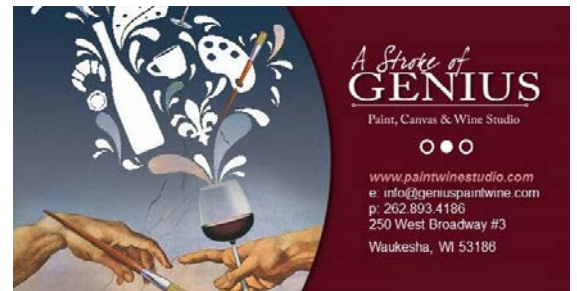
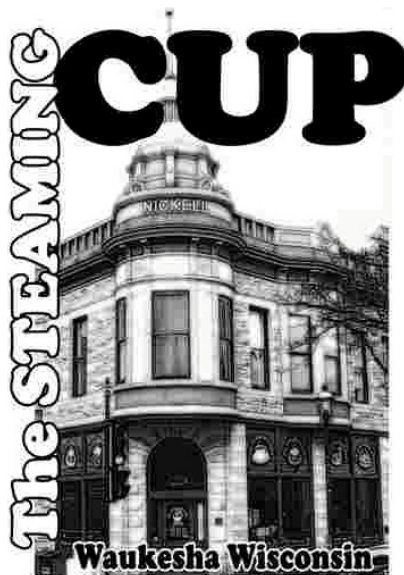

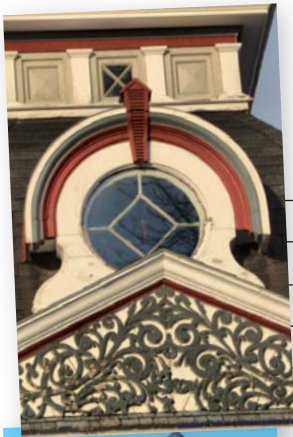

I am a Queen Anne that sits high above the street.



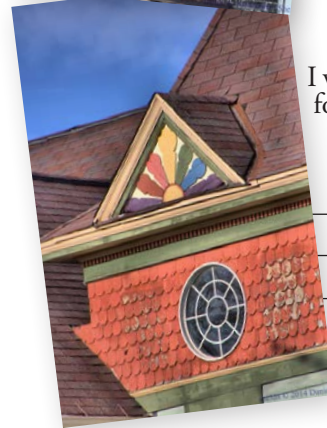
I was once the home of the president of Weber Brewery.
